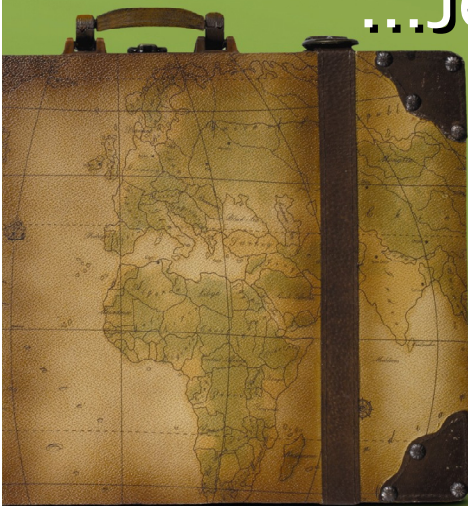
# The Mission is centered in Prayer!
